The New Brighton Residents Association (NBRA) camp program strives to provide a safe, fun and friendly environment that empowers children to develop new skills, explore their creativity, meet new friends, and enjoy the summer! Attendees will take part in activities that further enable the development of social skills, creativity and teamwork! Each week includes cooperative games, sports, water games, arts/crafts, experiments and learning related to the weekly theme!

This package includes forms that will provide us with contact/medical information, a check-list of all items that should be packed with your child daily, and other important information about camps. Please ensure you complete the forms and return it to the NBRA by **June 19th, 2023.**

What should I pack with my child daily?

- Spray on sunscreen
- Water bottle
- 2 peanut free snacks (AM & PM)
- Lunch
- Appropriate indoor/outdoor clothing (hat, shorts, jacket, swimsuit, water shoes and a towel)
- <u>All</u> medication your child may require (Please ensure you complete the Medical Form on Page 7 if you child needs medication)

New Brighton Summer Camps are designed to give your child engaging social interaction with other children. Therefore, it is asked that you **DO NOT** send your child to camp with any personal electronics or gaming devices (cell phones, tablet, Nintendo Switch, etc.). The electronic/gaming device will be confiscated until the end of the camp day.

Inside this Parent Package is important information regarding the rules and regulations around Summer Camps. Please review this package carefully and if you have further questions please feel free to contact the Summer Camp Leader Isaac Mehr or the Recreation Leader Jen Godziuk.

GENERAL INFORMATION

• Camps run from 9:00am to 4:00pm on a weekly basis. Children should arrive on time to avoid missing out on activities and disrupting other campers..

BEFORE AND AFTER CARE

• If your child attends the NBRA camps you receive complimentary before (7:30am-9:00am) and after (4:00pm-5:30pm) care on camp days. <u>Please note children cannot be dropped off any earlier than 7:30am and picked up no later than 5:30pm</u>. If you would like to take advantage of this complimentary service, please fill out the Before & After Care Sheet on <u>page 9</u>.

LUNCH/SNACKS

• Children must bring their own nutritious lunch, snacks and drinks each day. It is highly encouraged to send a water bottle daily with your child. Please note many of our lunches will be eaten outside, therefore please be mindful when preparing your child's lunch.

*Please refrain from sending your child with products containing peanuts and tree nuts due to allergy concerns. *

PHOTOGRAPHS

• Throughout the week, photos or videos may be taken of the campers and used for future publishing strictly by the NBRA. If you do not object please sign the Photograph Waiver on page_3 to allow photos be taken of your child. If you do not want photos or videos taken of your child please leave the Photograph Waiver blank.

INCLUSION POLICY

- The NBRA is unable to provide aids or one on one care for high needs children, and therefore
 this additional care must be provided by the <u>parent</u> if required. The aid must be present for
 the full duration of the camp. This is necessary due to Alberta regulations in regards to supervision ratio laws.
- New Brighton Residents Association reserves the right to request an aid for high needs children if one on one attention is required.
- Aide/Support Worker must be 17 years of age or older and provide a cleared security clearance (through the Calgary Police Service).
- Failure to provide an aid will result in the child being unable to attend the camps without a refund.

PARENT PACKAGE

• All campers are required to have this Parent Package returned, no later than **June 19th**, **2023**, in order to participate in the NBRA Summer Camps. Please send forms to camps@nbra.ca, fax to 403-781-6611 or drop it off in-person to the New Brighton Clubhouse Monday-Sunday 9am-9pm.

- Children should dress appropriately for the weather and camp activities.
- The NBRA asks that your child wear sunscreen on arrival to camps. Sunscreen should also be brought each day so children can reapply. Please only send your child with **spray on sunscreen!** Leaders are unable to apply sunscreen directly to your child's skin.
- Please provide a hat and water bottle each day for your child.
- Closed-toed shoes are a requirement to ensure the safety and comfort of your child during
 physical activity.
- Swimwear, a towel, and a form of waterproof footwear (sandals, water shoes, crocs, etc.) **are required** each day in order to participate in the daily splash park games and/or sports.
- Lost and found items will be held for one week. Unclaimed items may be donated after this time.
- * Don't forget to label your belongings with a name and phone number, so the NBRA staff members can ensure your child returns with all of their belongings*

SAFETY AND SECURITY

- For safety reasons, a parent or guardian must sign their child in and out each day. Children under the age of 8 years-old are not permitted to leave the day camp on their own. Please fill out the Authorization of Release located on PAGE 4 if someone else will be picking up your child and remind them to bring a piece of identification. It is also asked that you let us know in advance if someone other than a parent or guardian will be signing your child out.
- These policies & procedures are to be followed by all instructors, employees and volunteers at the NBRA during the Summer Camps, to ensure all participants are safe and protected during program instruction.

AIR QUALITY PROCEDURE

- The NBRA will be taking all precautions when it comes to the air quality warnings that may be in effect for Calgary this summer.
- The NBRA will be following the Air Quality Index Calgary guidelines from the Government of Canada when it comes to the amount of activity and time campers can safely spend outside.

WASHROOM PROCEDURES

- Changing for the Splash Park: In order for a child to use the Splash Park, the child must be able to fully change into their swim gear without assistance. If your child needs assistance changing in or out of their swim gear please sign the Washroom Assistance Waiver on Page 9
- Washroom Procedure: When a child requests a washroom break a spotter system will take place to ensure proper procedure is being followed. This allows the leaders to assist the child while under the vision of a second adult. There will be stepstools to ensure the child can comfortably get onto the toilet and wash their hands. Please note: we will encourage wiping but the child will not be physically touched due to Government of Alberta regulations. Any major accidents will result in the parent being contacted to do the changing process.

EPIPENS/MEDICATION

- If your child needs an EpiPen or any medication while at camp, please indicate so on page 7 under the medical fill information portion
- All EpiPen's/medications should be packed with your child each day of camp in a clear Ziploc bag with your child's name clearly labeled on it. The EpiPen/medication should be kept in the instructor's possession for the duration of the camp. This prevents the instructor from searching the child's belongings if an emergency occurs.



CANCELATION/ REFUND POLICY

A refund can be made in the form of a cheque, EFT, or a credit can be put on your NBRA account. All cheque refunds are subject to a \$15.75 administration fee. A credit can be placed on your NBRA account (valid for 1 year). All cancellations must be done in writing/email to the Recreation Leader at recreation@nbra.ca.

PLEASE NOTE: A \$60.00 non-refundable deposit is applied to each week of camps, when withdrawing from camps you will not receive this deposit back.

In certain circumstances, we will be forced to withdraw children from camp. Depending on the severity of the circumstances, notice may be waived. The following circumstances may warrant termination:

- Assault or threat of assault by parent/guardian will result in immediate termination.
- Non-payment of fees.
- Non-compliance with the policies and procedures of the site.
- Parents' use of abusive language or any inappropriate behavior towards others.
- Any destructive, violent behavior by a child that is harmful to the child, staff, property or other children.
- Consistent lateness in picking up a child *Please note that depending on the situation your child may be temporarily suspended from the program and parents will be required to find alternate arrangements.

Sign In and Sign Out Policy

Sign in:

- All parents/guardian's dropping camper off must sign them in. The sign in sheet will be located inside the classroom (Banquet Room) with the Summer Camp Leader.
- The parent/guardian must write down the time of drop off and the name of the authorized pick up for the day.

Sign out:

- Children must be signed out at the end of each day by a parent, guardian or individual stated on the authorization of release form.
- Sign out form will be located in the classroom (Banquet Room) with the camp leaders.
- Any parent, guardian or individual picking up a child from the NBRA summer camps will be required to show <u>photo identification</u> before the child is released in their care. This will be used to match their name with the names on the authorization of release from sign in (if the person picking up is not on the approved list, we will <u>NOT</u> release the child to this person)

To allow your child to sign themselves out (child must be 8+), there will be a form available in the parent package that parents/guardians to read and sign. If this form is not signed by a parent or guardian, the child will not be allowed to leave camp on their own. One form will be kept for our records for the entire summer.

Authorization of Release

A parent or guardian **MUST** advise the instructor if someone else will be picking up their child. The parent or guardian needs to provide this person's full name and contact phone number to the instructor and that person must bring a piece of photo ID for the child to be released to them. No child is to be released to anyone that has not been given the expressed permission of the parent or guardian.
