**RE: The Canada Skateboard Open Skateboard Competition – Notice of Noise By-law Exception Permit**

Dear Residents,

Please be advised that a noise by-law exception permit has been granted by the City of Calgary at The New Brighton Skateboard park for Saturday July 8th and Sunday July 9th , 2023.

The event will begin set up between 6-7 pm Saturday July 8th and will continue until 10:00 pm. During this time the noise will be kept to a minimum as we load in event supplies and start to set up for the following day's events.

The set up will continue on Sunday morning, July 9th from 7 am - 9 am. During this time the noise will be kept to a minimum as we finalize setting up tents and infrastructure.

The event will start on Sunday July 9th at 10am - 6pm. During this time we will be running music, announcements and directives to the participants on the course.

There will be equipment operating that include: a P/A system & a generator. The noise will consist of a light humming noise from the generator, music and announcements from the P/A system.

The following steps will be taken to mitigate the noise impact: during the day we will aim all speakers into the park, directing the sound onto the course, set at a reasonable level. We will monitor the sound from the P/A system throughout the day to keep it at a consistent volume. Staff will be required to use cell phones and word of mouth communication.
