

#### **Mason Bees in the Community**

The May long weekend is when it is recommended to put the Mason bees outside. You can find some interesting facts about these gentle bees on our page 'Mason Bees' at ournewbrighton.ca/mason-bees/ and, of course, by a simple search on the internet.

Did you know that Calgary is a bee city? This means that our city has preserved natural areas for bees to live in. We only have 22 bee cities in Canada with over 20,000 species. One species you can keep in your backyard is the Mason bee, they are great to have because they are three times more active than honeybees. They are also highly unlikely to sting; this makes them great if you have kids that want to look inside the nesting tubes. These bees have a range of about 100 meters which means they benefit you and your close neighbours the most.

Mason bees are relatively easy to take care of too! All you need is half an hour to set up the house, water, and clay/mud. You can find all these supplies online from Canadian producers. Two or three Mason bees can pollinate a full-size apple tree. If you see people not getting rid of dandelions don't be rude, thank them instead. Bees love eating dandelions because it is a vital source of food and pollen for many types of bees, birds, and beetles. So, try leaving your weeds in your yard to help these hard-working insects survive.

#### **Unmarked Crosswalks**

We experience a lot of near misses in our community involving pedestrians crossing the street, and as much as everyone wants more crosswalks and signage, there need to be a lot of criteria met in order to grant those. Did you know that at unmarked crosswalks you need to yield to pedestrians, and you can get a ticket for not doing so?

Alberta rules say an unmarked crosswalk is the part of a roadway that connects two sidewalks, curbs, or edges of a road at an intersection where that roadway crosses another—think of an invisible line drawn corner to corner straight across the road. Unmarked crosswalks exist at all intersections unless a sign states otherwise.

The pedestrians have the right of way in a crosswalk unless a peace officer or traffic control device directs otherwise. This means that even if the crosswalk is unmarked, vehicles must stop and yield to pedestrians. Drivers should make sure to watch for the elderly or people with disabilities who may take more time crossing. Failing to yield to a pedestrian in a crosswalk will result in a \$810 fine and four demerit points. However, as a pedestrian you are still responsible for exercising due care even though you have the right-of-way, and you should make sure that all vehicles have yielded before entering the crosswalk. July 1, 2025 Outstanding accounts will be sent to Walsh LLP for collections. incurring additional legal fees. The NBRA no longer accepts fee payments directly.



#### **SAFE AND SOUND**

#### **Window and Balcony Safety**

With the return of warmer weather, Emergency Medical Services (EMS) would like to remind parents and caregivers of an often-overlooked hazard in the home – access to open windows. Every year, paramedics respond to emergencies where a child has fallen from an open window, often from the second floor. These can be avoided by following safety measures. Take the time to assess potential hazards in your home before a preventable fall occurs.

#### **Windows and Screens**

- Prevent access to windows by moving furniture such as cribs, beds, stools, and change tables out from under them.
- Keep drapery cords out of children's' reach. Wrap excess cord around cleats or tie-downs to avoid a choking hazard.
- Remember, screens are not safety devices. They are designed to keep bugs out, not children in.

#### **Balconies**

- Do not underestimate a child's ability to climb. Furniture and other items stored on balconies and decks can be used to climb resulting in falls over the railing.
- Ensure that your balcony railings are not more than 10 cm (4 inch) apart. This will eliminate access between the vertical bars of a balcony or deck.

#### **Further Prevention Tips**

- Toddlers and preschoolers are at highest risk of falling from a window or balcony, but it may happen at any age.
- Direct supervision of children is the single most effective way to prevent falls from windows and balconies.
- Install safety devices which limit the distance in which a window be can open to a maximum of 10 cm (4 inches).
- Ensure the safety device can be released quickly, so the window can be used for escape in case of emergency.
- Consider purchasing a portable air conditioner, which will enable windows to stay closed and secure.


