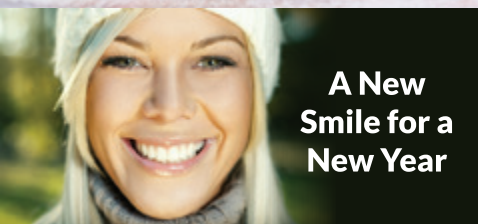

## Safety In Our Community

You can put your outside lights on a timer and have peace of mind with the night schedule for the lights. It is a small investment that can have a big impact on the overall safety, let's make our nights brighter.

I'm grateful for my home, family and friends.

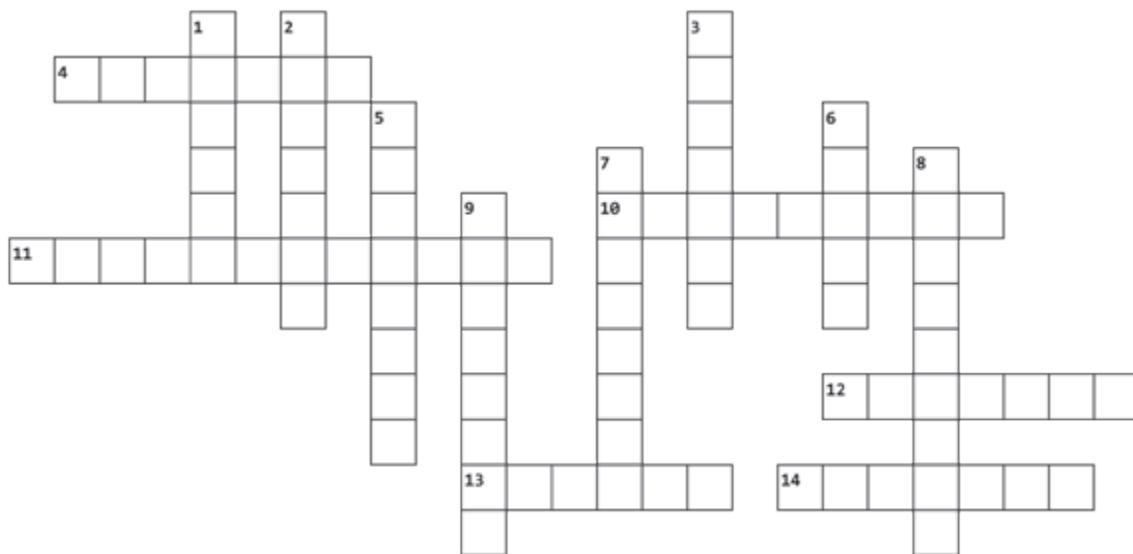

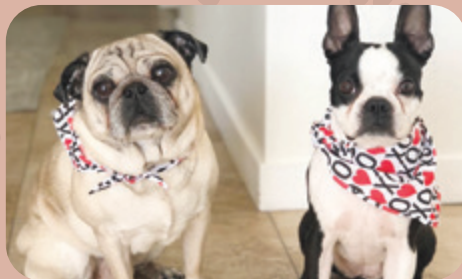

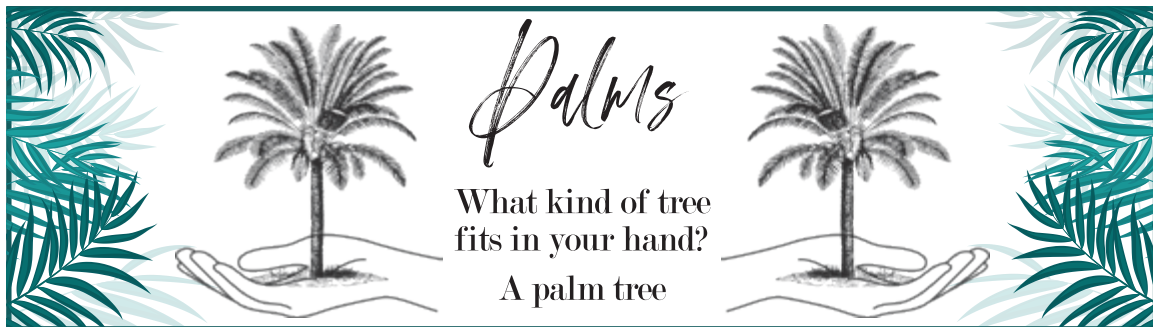

## Snow Removal

Once these areas are complete, the NBRA team will proceed into the community. All other days will remain open during regular hours from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm.
