

## Covid-19 Guidelines for Room Rentals at New Brighton Residents Association

The New Brighton Residents Association is closely monitoring developments related to COVID-19 and following guidelines from local health authorities. The health and safety of our residents, staff and patrons are the highest importance to the New Brighton Residents Association.

# We ask that all renters and their guests adhere to the following regulations in regards to Covid-19 and indoor social gatherings

- Maintain a capacity of 50 people or less in the Banquet room
- Maintain a capacity of 20 people or less in the Studio room.
- Use Skate change room bathroom and upstairs bathrooms.
- Stay home if displaying any cold or flu like symptoms, or have traveled in the past 14 days.
- Encourage all guests to remain 2 metres away from all other guests in order to practice physical distancing.
- Wear a face mask in the case a distance of 2 metres cannot be maintained between everyone in the group.
- Use hand sanitizer or wash hands on a regular basis.
- Serving food buffet style or self-serve is not permitted. It is recommended that each household or cohort be responsible for providing food for their own individual group.

### **High-risk activities**

COVID-19 can be transmitted by touching objects or surfaces the virus has landed on then touching your eyes, nose or mouth. During a global pandemic, one of the easiest, and most important ways to prevent the spread of the virus is to wash your hands frequently with soap and water.

Activities that carry this risk are not recommended, even with physical distancing in place, including:

- Sharing food, drinks or utensils
- Sharing equipment
- Close-range conversations
- Singing
- Direct physical contact or touch with people outside of your household

### **Hygiene Requirements**

Employees & Guests are asked to keep touchpoints to a minimum when entering and exiting the New Brighton property including, but not limited to:

- Door handles
- Railings
- Gates
- Light switches
- Wheelchair Access Button



#### **City of Calgary Bylaw**

The City of Calgary has implemented a temporary bylaw requiring individuals to wear face coverings in all buildings that are open to the public. As per the bylaw, renters who are hosting private events within our facility are an exception as the room rented is not open to the public. We do request that all individuals wear a face covering when they are not in the private rented space; this includes, but is not limited to, when they are entering or leaving the building, unloading or loading supplies and accessing the public washrooms or shared kitchen space.
