Construction work will occur in various locations along Mahogany Boulevard SE, between Mahogany Terrace SE and Marquis Common SE.

**Dates:**

**Phase 1:** Preliminary work (site assessments, utility locating and surveying) have been completed.

**Phase 2:** Construction is anticipated to begin in early summer 2022 and will take approximately three (3) weeks. Residents that live near the construction area will receive additional notification in advance of construction with further details.

**Phase 3:** Site-restoration will occur following construction activities (weather permitting).

### What's happening?

This summer, ENMAX Power will be replacing a section of underground electrical cable that supplies power to the neighborhoods of Mahogany, Copperfield and New Brighton.

Construction will occur in Mahogany; however, this infrastructure upgrade will benefit all three communities.

We understand that this work may create some inconveniences, and we thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation as we deliver on our commitment to provide safe and reliable power to all Calgarians.

### What to expect:

We make every effort to minimize the effect our work has on daily activities, and we follow all applicable standards and bylaws. Below are the things to be aware of related to this project.

#### Phase 1 - Site assessment, surveying, and utility locating **\*COMPLETE\***

#### Phase 2 - Construction:

- ENMAX and contractor vehicles, bucket trucks, hydrovac and associated utility equipment will be onsite.
- Construction barricades and/or safety fencing will be placed in certain areas.
- Road signage near work area may be required.
- Noise and/or minor vibrations during construction.
- A planned power outage will be required to tie-in the new infrastructure at the end of this project. If your property is affected by this outage, you will be given advance notice to help you plan ahead and be prepared.

#### Phase 3 - Site restoration:

- Areas affected by construction will be repaired once work is complete (weather permitting).
- Ongoing maintenance of repaired areas on private property will be the responsibility of the homeowner/property manager.
