## ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE + MUSEUM MAP

### ARRIVAL PROCEDURES: FRIDAY/SATURDAY NIGHT, 6:30 P.M. TO 7:00 P.M.

#### WELCOME **Arrive at the Museum at 6:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.**

- Camp-In staff will unlock the Tyrrell Learning Centre doors at 6:30 p.m. to allow access to the facility. The Museum closes at 5:00 p.m. and is locked and unavailable until 6:30 p.m.

#### DROP-OFF **Go straight on the one-way road and around the hill to the drop-off zones on the attached diagram.**

- **Please unload your gear in the drop-off zone areas:**  
Regular passenger vehicles – unload in the “PUBLIC DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP ZONE” just before the fire lane  
Buses – unload in the “BUSES ONLY DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP ZONE” past the fire lane.
- *Idling or parking in the Fire Lane is NOT permitted at any time.*
- After unloading, the vehicle(s) should be parked in the general parking lot.

#### GET SETTLED IN

- As your group exits the vehicles, the GROUP ORGANIZER should enter the Tyrrell Learning Centre lobby (marked with “CAMP-IN ENTRANCE” on the map).
- The Host(ess)/ Camp-In staff will greet you in the lobby and provide you with your registration package.
- **Please note your assigned group number(s).**
- CAMPERS should go to the Tyrrell Learning Centre entrance with their gear. Everyone should wait at their assigned group number (posted in the lobby) until the entire group has arrived.
- Take a group head count (total number of participants including chaperones and campers).
- Next, Camp-In staff will escort you into *Dinosaur Hall*; listen carefully to the instructions about sleeping arrangements. Everyone may drop off their gear, but there is no need to unpack as there will be plenty of time to do so at bedtime.
- Go directly back to the Tyrrell Learning Centre lobby and proceed into the auditorium for orientation.

#### LET THE FUN BEGIN

- The Host/ess will ask for your group’s total number of participants.
- After the orientation, the Host/ess will lead you back to the Tyrrell Learning Centre for exciting palaeo programming until bedtime snack.

### DEPARTURE PROCEDURES: SATURDAY/SUNDAY MORNING

#### RISE AND SHINE **Wake up call is at 7:30 a.m.**

- Pack up your gear, bring it to the lobby, and have it ready to load into your vehicle(s) in the drop-off/ pick-up zones from 7:30–8:45 a.m.
- Breakfast is served in the Cafeteria beginning at 8:15 a.m. *Due to limited storage space, all gear must be out of the building before 9:00 a.m.*

#### GALLERY VISIT

- The Museum Shop opens at 9:30 a.m.
- Beginning at 10:00 a.m. you have FREE ADMISSION to the Museum for the day. Enjoy your visit!

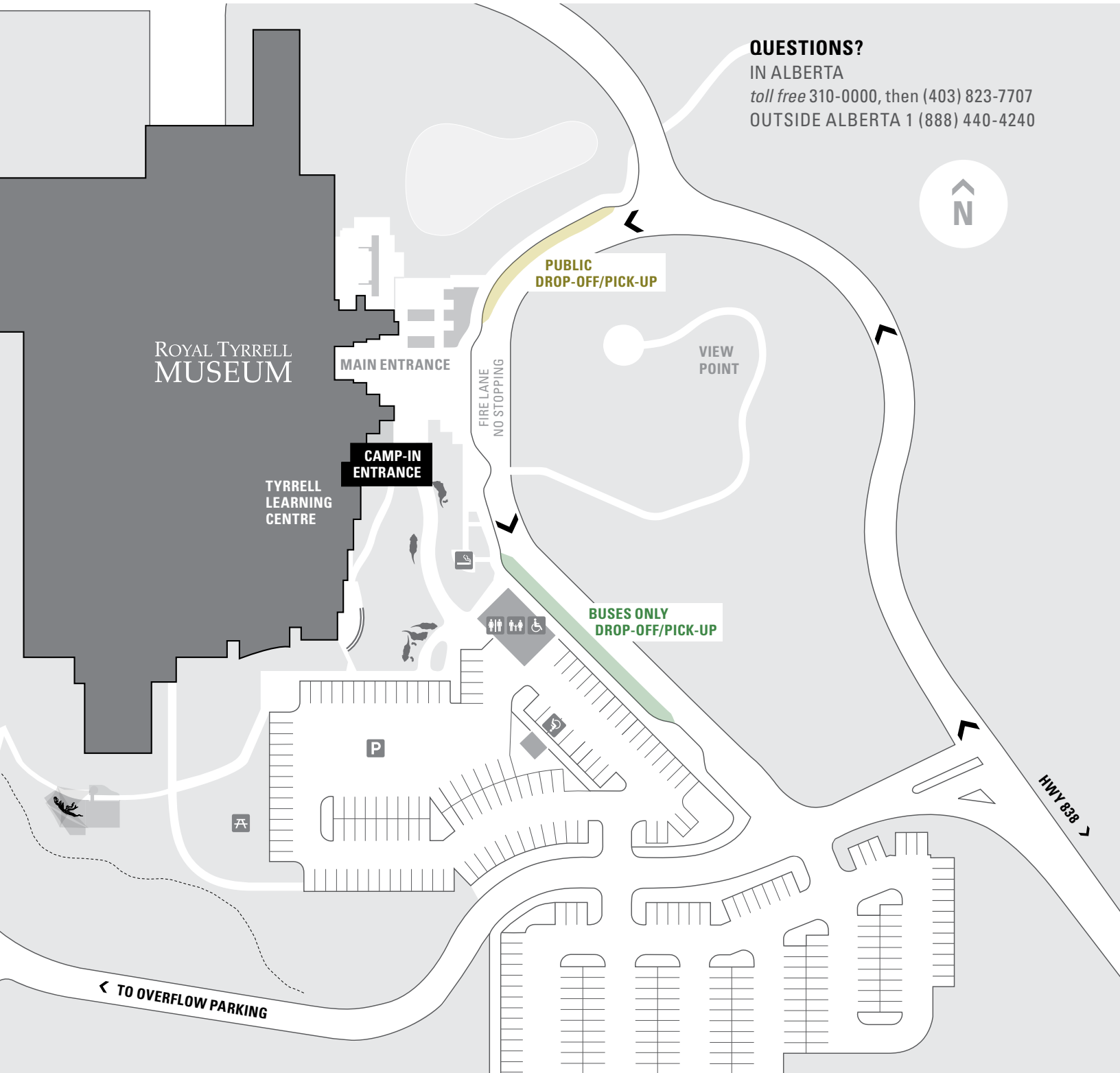
