The New Brighton Residents Association Annual Golf Tournament is back for a fourth year in a row! Hosted at the beautiful McKenzie Meadows Golf Club on **Sunday**, **September 7th, 2025 starting at 12:30pm.** Register your **team of 4** to enjoy a fun afternoon of golf, with the opportunity to win some great prizes, and save room for a delicious banquet dinner after the game.

This event is strictly 18+.

- 18 holes of golf (crossover style)

Tournament Fee...

- Resident Rate: \$500+GST per team
 - Each team must consist of 4 players
 - Only 1 member of your team is required to live within New Brighton to receive this "Resident Rate"
- Non-Resident Rate: \$600+GST per team
 - Each team must consist of 4 players

Tournament Style - Crossover

Teams of 4 will compete to get the lowest score possible. *Teams will either begin on Hole* #1 or #10 with staggered start times from 12:30pm. **Men shall play from White Tees and Ladies shall play from Gold Tees.** All players will tee off from the appropriate tee deck, once the tee shot is made you may select the best drive from amongst your group.

- After shots are made, the team will pick the best ball and play from that location
- To help maintain the flow of the tournament, players will pick up the ball once they have reached double bogey
- Each player will receive 1 free mulligan to use during the tournament
 - Only 1 mulligan can be used per hole, per team
 - Only 1 mulligan can be used on the green per person
 - Only 1 mulligan can be used off the green per person
 - No mulligans may be used at tournament "Competition Holes"

Keep the group in front of you in sight at all times to help maintain the pace of play. If your group falls 1 hole behind, your group will be asked to pick your golf ball up and return to the correct position. Thank you.

Cancellation Policy

All cancellations must be done in writing **via email to events@nbra.ca** or be dropped off to the New Brighton Clubhouse at 2 New Brighton Drive SE. Methods of refund include an account credit, EFT, or cheque. Credits can be used towards yearly membership fees, programs, rentals, canteen items, and summer camp registrations. *Account credits are valid for 1 year*. All cancellations will be confirmed by Events Coordinator before refund is given.

McKenzie Meadows Rules and Regulations

Dress Code: All players, volunteers and organizers must comply with the McKenzie Meadows dress code. Men must have a collared shirt, while ladies may wear a shirt without a collar providing it has sleeves, or may wear a sleeveless shirt providing it has a collar. <u>Anyone wearing jeans, sweatpants, cut-offs, gym shorts, tank tops, halter tops or attire displaying inappropriate slogans, words or pictures will be denied access to the course.</u>

Equipment Rental: Each player requires a set of golf clubs--sharing of clubs is not permitted. Should any participant require golf club rentals, please make arrangements with the Tournament Manager at least 10 days in advance of the tournament.

Traps, Divots, & Ball Marks: Please replace all divots, rake all sand traps, and repair your ball mark and at least one other on the green. Sand and seed bottles can be found on the golf carts. Please fill divots with our sand/seed mixture.

Speed of Play: Player Assistants are on-course to monitor conduct, speed of play, and to assist players with any needs that may arise out on the golf course. All tournaments are required to maintain a pace of play, as stated in Tournament Agreement. If a tournament has reached the 5-hour limit, McKenzie Meadows retains the right to ask all tournament players to finish the hole they are currently playing and leave the course.





McKenzie Meadows Rules and Regulations

Weather: The Tournament will not be cancelled due to cold, wind, or rainy weather. If, at the discretion of the Course Superintendent, the golf course should become closed or unplayable, an alternate date and time will be chosen for golf. If a new date cannot be arranged, a refund shall be issued for the golf portion only. The banquet will take place, as scheduled, regardless of weather.

Beverages: GLASS BOTTLES, PERSONAL COOLERS OR OTHER BEVERAGE RECEPTACLE DEVICES ARE NOT PERMITTED AT THE GOLF COURSE AND WILL BE CONFISCATED IF FOUND ON THE PREMISE (AS PER AGLC LAW 6.5.7). Anyone bringing his or her own beverage, unless otherwise arranged or agreed to, will be asked to leave the course.

<u>Player Assistants will recommend some of the following helpful</u> <u>pointers, which will enable you to keep up the speed of play...</u>

- 1.Play ready golf have every member of your team proceed to their ball as quickly as possible so everyone is ready to play when it's their turn
- 2.Keep up with the group in front of you. Your place on the course is directly behind the group in front of you.

Conduct: McKenzie Meadows Golf Club reserve the right to refuse service to anyone that does not adhere to course rules.


