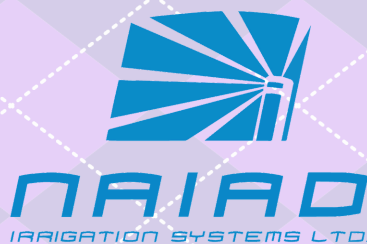




5th Annual New Brighton Golf Tournament Package

The New Brighton Residents Association Annual Golf Tournament is back for a 5th year in a row! Hosted at the beautiful McKenzie Meadows Golf Club on **Sunday, September 13th, 2026 starting at 12pm**. Register your **team of 4** to enjoy a fun afternoon of golf, have the chance to win some great prizes, and save room for a delicious banquet dinner after the game.

This event is strictly 18+.

Tournament Includes...

- 18 holes of golf (crossover start)
- Team power carts

Tournament Fee...

- Resident Rate: \$525+GST **per team**
 - Each team **must** consist of 4 players
 - **Only 1 member** of your team is required to live within New Brighton to receive this “Resident Rate”
- Non-Resident Rate: \$625+GST **per team**
 - Each team **must** consist of 4 players

Registration Deadline: August 27th, 2026, at noon.



Tournament Style

Teams of 4 will compete to get the lowest score possible. *Teams will begin on Hole #1 or #10 with staggered start times from 12pm as chosen by McKenzie Meadows.*

- Men shall play from middle **(white)** tee boxes
- Ladies shall play from forward **(gold)** tee boxes

All players will tee off from the appropriate tee box, once the tee shot is made you may select the best drive from amongst your group.

- After shots are made, each team will pick the best ball & play from that location
- To help maintain the flow of the tournament, players will pick up the ball if they have reached double bogey

Each player will receive 1 free mulligan to use during the tournament

- Only 1 mulligan can be used *per hole, per team*
- No mulligans may be used *at tournament "Competition Holes"*
 - **Holes 1, 4, 13, 17**

Keep the group in front of you in sight at all times to help maintain the pace of play. If your group falls 1 hole behind, your group may be asked to pick your ball up and return to the correct position. Thank you.

Cancellation Policy

All cancellations must be done in writing **via email to events@nbra.ca** or be dropped off to the New Brighton Clubhouse at 2 New Brighton Drive SE. Methods of refund include account credit, EFT, or cheque. Credit can be used towards yearly New Brighton membership fees, programs, rentals, canteen items, and summer camp registrations. Account credits are valid for 1 year. All cancellations must be confirmed by the Events Coordinator before the refund is given.

Cancelling before 5pm on August 14th - Full Refund

Cancelling after 5pm on August 14th - No Refund



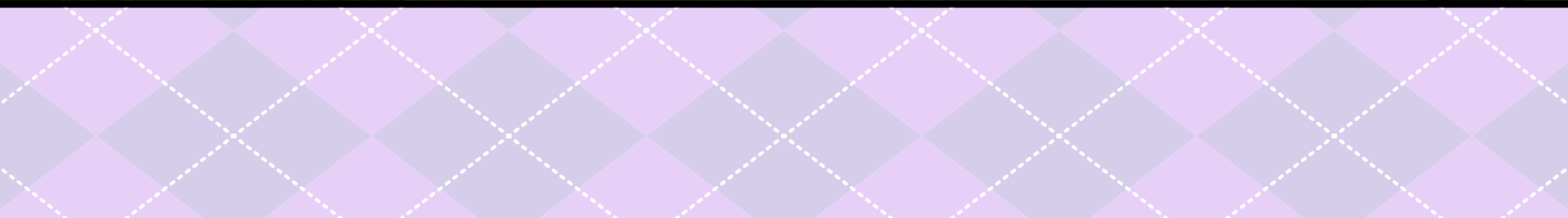
McKenzie Meadows Rules and Regulations

Dress Code: All players, volunteers and organizers must comply with the McKenzie Meadows dress code. Men must have a collared shirt, while ladies may wear a shirt without a collar providing it has sleeves, or may wear a sleeveless shirt providing it has a collar. Anyone wearing jeans, sweatpants, cut-offs, gym shorts, tank tops, halter tops or attire displaying inappropriate slogans, words or pictures will be denied access to the course.

Equipment Rental: Each player requires a set of golf clubs--sharing of clubs is not permitted. Should any participant require golf club rentals, please make arrangements with the Tournament Manager at least 10 days in advance of the tournament.

Traps, Divots, & Ball Marks: Please replace all divots, rake all sand traps, and repair your ball mark and at least one other on the green. Sand and seed bottles can be found on the golf carts. Please fill divots with our sand/seed mixture.

Speed of Play: Player Assistants are on-course to monitor conduct, speed of play, and to assist players with any needs that may arise out on the golf course. All tournaments are required to maintain a pace of play, as stated in Tournament Agreement. If a tournament has reached the 5-hour limit, McKenzie Meadows retains the right to ask all tournament players to finish the hole they are currently playing and leave the course.





McKenzie Meadows Rules and Regulations

Weather: The Tournament will not be cancelled due to cold, wind, or rainy weather. If, at the discretion of the Course Superintendent, the golf course should become closed or unplayable, an alternate date and time will be chosen for golf. If a new date cannot be arranged, a refund shall be issued for the golf portion only. The banquet will take place, as scheduled, regardless of weather.

Beverages: GLASS BOTTLES, PERSONAL COOLERS OR OTHER BEVERAGE RECEPTACLE DEVICES ARE NOT PERMITTED AT THE GOLF COURSE AND WILL BE CONFISCATED IF FOUND ON THE PREMISE (AS PER AGLC LAW 6.5.7). Anyone bringing his or her own beverage, unless otherwise arranged or agreed to, will be asked to leave the course.

Player Assistants will recommend some of the following helpful pointers, which will enable you to keep up the speed of play...

1. Play ready golf - have every member of your team proceed to their ball as quickly as possible so everyone is ready to play when it's their turn
2. Keep up with the group in front of you. Your place on the course is directly behind the group in front of you.

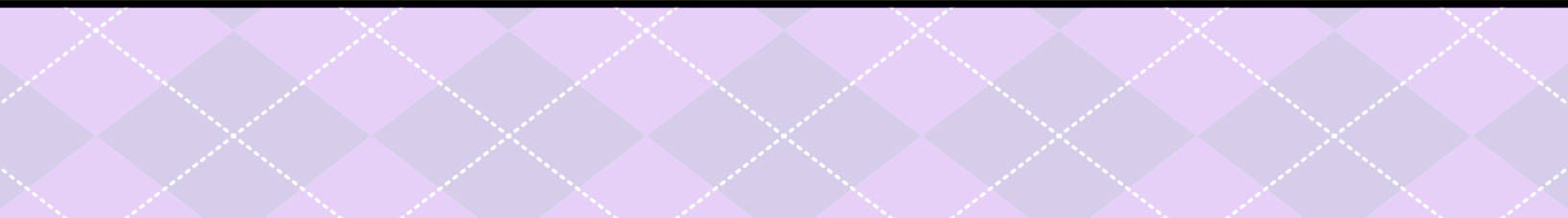
